### **Declaration of Conformity with EU Directive 2011/65 / EU (RoHS-II)**

Alu Menziken Extrusion AG confirms that its mill-finished and anodized aluminium profiles correspond in principle with the requirements of the EU Directive 2011/65 / EU "Restrictions of Hazardous Substances" (RoHS-II) and the delegated Directive 2015/863.

The exceptions are aluminium alloys where the lead content exceeds 0.4% by weight. The name of the alloy as well as the associated lead content can be found in the following list:

EN AW-2007 = 0.80 - 1.50%  
EN AW-2011 = 0.20 - 0.60%  
EN AW-2030 = 0.80 - 1.50%  
EN AW-6012 = 0.40 - 2.00%  
EN AW-6018 = 0.40 - 1.20 %

For profiles and components that have surface treatments other than anodizing, for example "painting or powder coating", the conformity must be checked on a case-by-case basis according to the parts list and customer requirements. The same procedure is used for our products that are combined with non-aluminium materials.
